OUR LADY OF FATIMA - MAY 13, 2024:

This title was given to the Blessed Virgin Mary after she appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal between May 13 and October 13, 1917. The three messaged or 'secrets' of Fatma stress the importance of repentance, conversion of heart, and dedication to Our Lady, especially through daily prayer of the Rosary.

COLLECTION FOR THE POPE'S WORKS - May 5, 2024:

This collection, held on the 6th Sunday of Easter, allows Catholics to contribute financially to assis in the important work of the Holy father. One-third of the funds collected support the Popo's charity known as Peter's Pence. Two-thirds of the Collection for the Pope's Pastoral Works directly supports the pastoral mission of the Holy Father in his service to the Universal Church by funding the various Secretariats, Dicasteries, Academies, and other institutions of the Holy See. Through these institutions, the work of the Pope as the "perpetual and visible principle and foundation of unity" is enabled and fostered.

The monies distributed to Peter's Pence, in addition to funding the various institutions of the Holy See, are also used to assist the poor and those in need.

At a time when our world appears to be witnessing a growing number of wars and conflicts that create poverty and great need across the glove, we have the opportunity to collaborate with the Pope in responding to these needs. As Pope Francis stated in his Message for the 2034 World Day of the Poor: "we must once more acknowledge new forms of poverty...I think in particular of peoples caught up in situations of was, and especially children deprived of the serene present and a dignified future. We should never grow accustomed to such situations. Let us persevere in our effort to foster peach as a gift of the risen Lord and fruit of a commitment to justice and dialogue".
